"Survey of E and W $\frac{1}{4}$ line from E $\frac{1}{4}$ post to interior $\frac{1}{4}$ post on sec. 3, June 22, 1904 for Samuel Reed. Chainmen - S. Reed and Frank Reed.

Gurley transit chain = 66.46'

Commenced at E $\frac{1}{4}$ post of sec. 3 which is a wooden stake with crockery and set off to N. 52 links. Ran S89 $\frac{1}{2}$ °W 28 chains. Set off to S111 $\frac{1}{2}$ lks. then ran W. on parallel line to N & S $\frac{1}{4}$ line at a point 65 links S. of interior $\frac{1}{4}$ post. The line over ran 10 lks. E & W making the measurement 40 chains and 10 links. Corrected the line back.

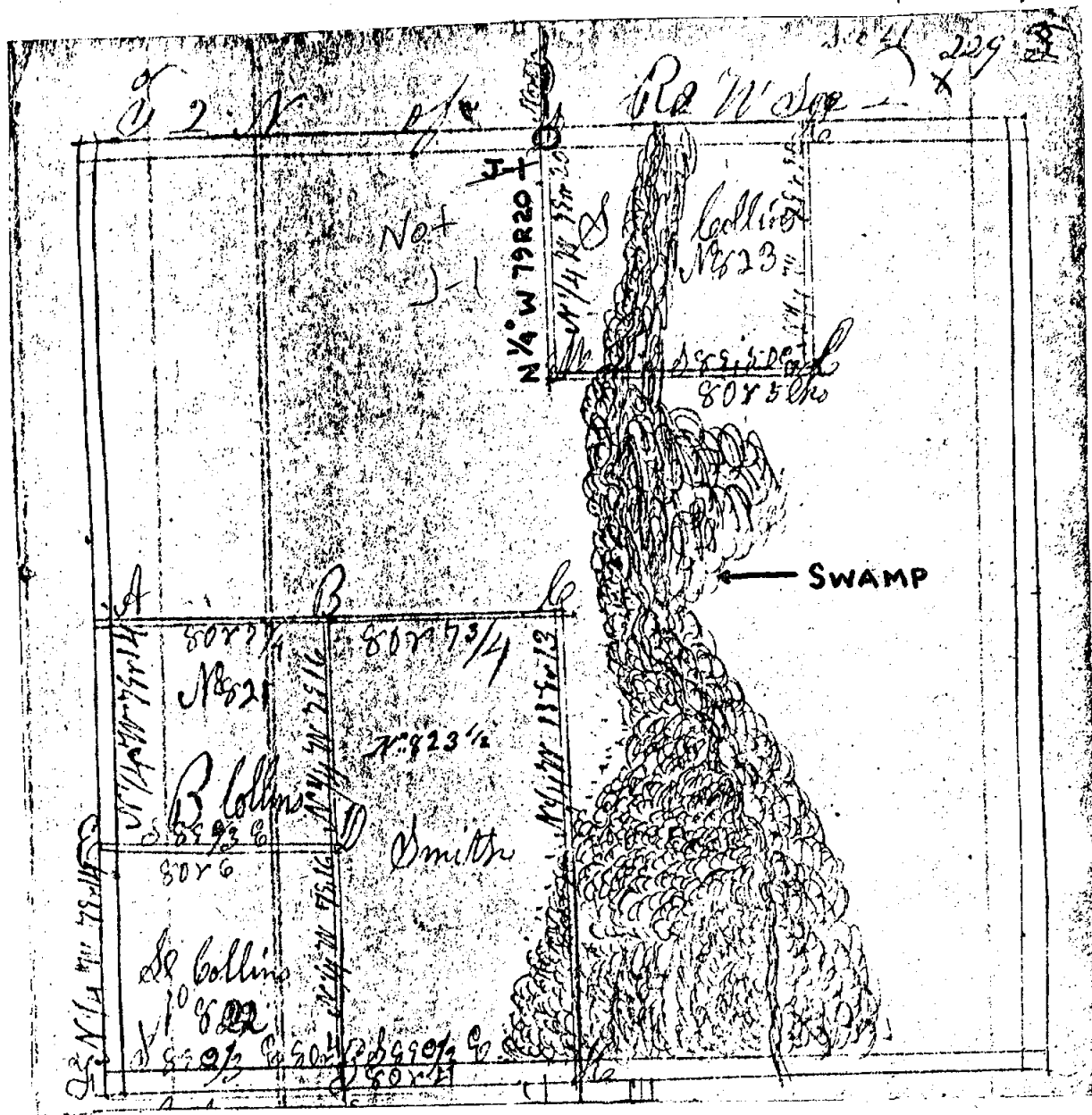
