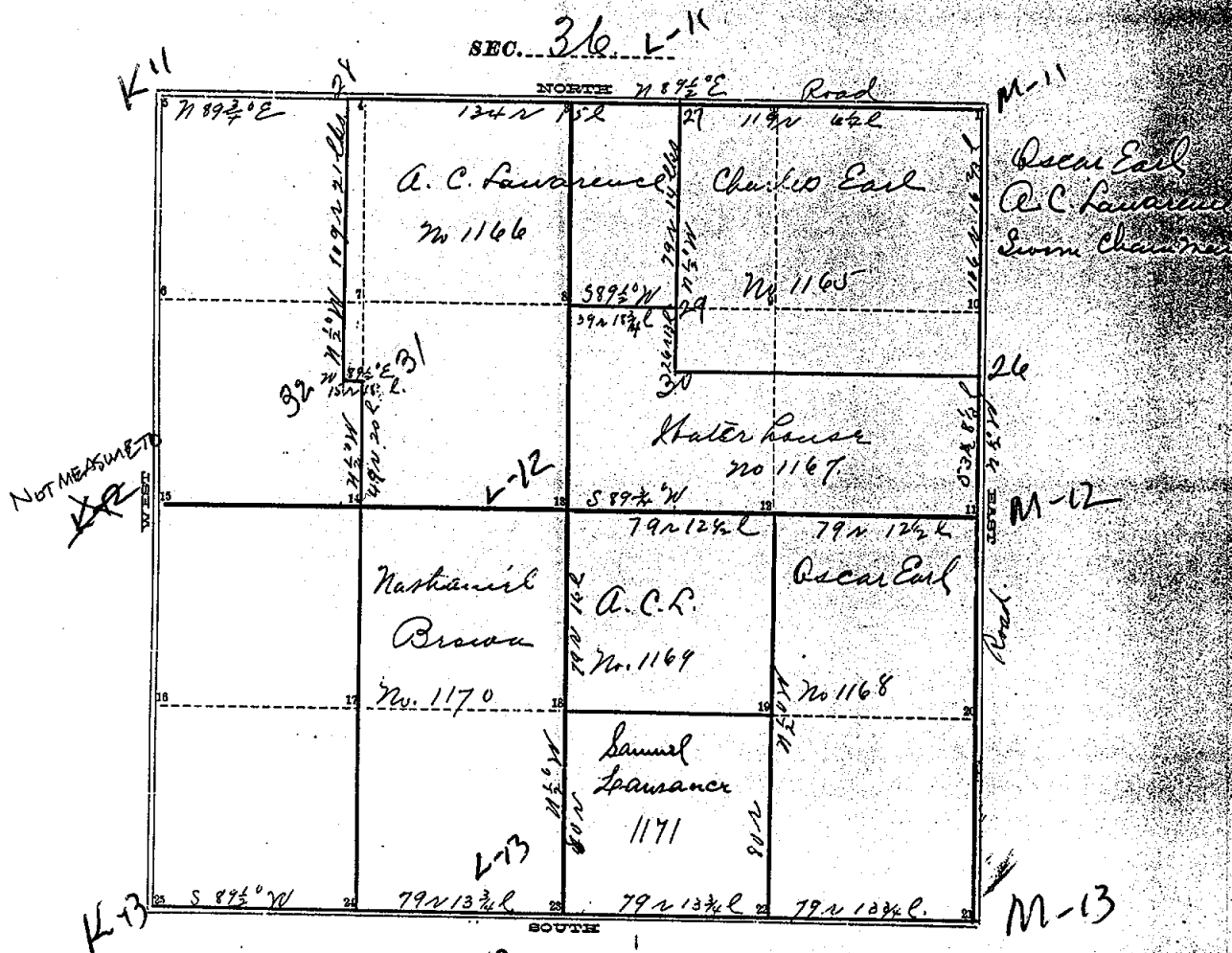

TOWN One NORTH, RANGE One East, MERIDIAN OF MICHIGAN.

Survey of the east 3/4 of section 36 of town No 1 north of Range No One East. Commencing at the S.E. cor of the said section resurveyed by "21" in the plot and run thence S 89 1/2° W 318 r 5 links to said section 35 & 36; thence corrected & set a post at "24" from which a Black Oak 12 inches diameter bears N 44 3/4° W 94 lks & N. O 26 inches N 69° W 137 lks, "23" from N. O 6 in. N 28 1/4° W, 60 lks, & Surf 7 in. N 30 1/2° E 168 1/2 lks, "22" from Willow 4 inches N 76 1/2° E 146 lks & Poplar 1 in. N 50° W 69 lks & "21" from N. Oak 10 in N 24° W 448 1/2 lks & Black Walnut 3 inches N 33° E, 333 lks; thence from "23" N 1 1/2° W 80 r set post from a Maple 5 in bearing N 6 1/2° E 5 lks & Do 5 inches N 63 1/2° W 11 lks; thence Do 79 rds 16 l to post "13" from a Y. Oak 8 inches S 45 1/2° W, 15 links. Set by a Jackson, ^{Co. Surv.} 1840, New bearing N. O 32 inches N 89 3/4° E 246 lks; thence N 89 3/4° E 149 rds to "11" from which a Hickory 6 inches bears N 64° E 30 1/2 lks and Do 8 S 10 1/2° W 286 lks. Thence corrected "12" Tamarac 10 inches N 21 1/2° W 17 lks; thence N 1 1/2° W 160 rds & from the best evidence set a post "1" from a Hickory 4 inches N 40 1/2° W 83 lks; Hickory 8 inches S 41 1/2° W, 73 1/2 lks, and N. O 8. N 20 1/2° W 160 1/2 l. Corrected post "26" from an Elm 12 inches N 87 3/4° W 31 1/2 lks & Surf. Oak 4 inches N 19 3/4° W 110 lks; thence South 89 1/2° West 159 rds to 1/2 post set at "27" from a Willow 4 inches S 17° E 31 1/2 l & Do 3 in. S 27 1/2° W 20 1/2 l. Distance between "27" and "1" is 119 r 64 l; Thence westerly in random line 158 r 5 lks to sec corners 28, 26, 35 & 36. Corrected N 89 3/4° E set post "28" from N. O 3 in N 31 1/2° E 47 l & N. O 2 in S 13° E 51 1/2 lks. Distance between "28" & "27" is 134 rds 5 lks. Then commenced at "27" run S 1/2° E 79 r 14 l. Set post "29" thence Do 26 r 13 l set post "30" Thence from "22" N 1 1/2° W 80 r set post "19" from Tamarac 12 inches S 28° W 146 l. Thence from "29" South 89 1/2° West 39 rds 18 3/4 lks set post "8" from N. O 2 inches S 10 1/2° W, 22 lks, & same 2 inches N 10 1/2° E 13 lks. Thence commenced at "14" set by some one from which a N. O 14 inches bears N 66° E, 4 lks, & Hickory 2 inches N 77 1/2° W 9 l. run N 1 1/2° W 49 rds 20 lks to "31" N. O 8 N 89 3/4° E 367 lks; thence S 89 1/2° W 15 rds 18 3/4 lks to "32" N. O 40 inches S 68 1/2° W 55 lks, Do 8 in. N 36 3/4° W 44 lks; Thence N 1 1/2° W 109 rds 21 lks to "28" Run by its Magnetic Var. 2 3/4° E. Surveyed & Recorded Mar 1st 1885

In survey No 1822 a portion of the west half of the North
west one fourth of section No. Thirty six of the town ship of Benken
is shown comprising a part of the village of Fitchburg, which
is shown in two plats as shown on account of errors in deeds.
The parcel of land seven rods N & S by 13 rods E & W owned
by Louisa Hawler and by her husband John Miller & Blake Dawney
is entirely covered by Blake Dawney's deed and is only shown
in dotted skeleton letters and figures in the plat on the left
hand side of the page, but is shown in full upon the right
hand side of the page. The right hand plat only covers land
lying south of the east and west street which is situated 38
rods south of the north section line of Section 36. It seems
that the deeds of Kato cover one another and they all cover two
rods more land North & South than there is in the actual
measurement from the section corner of Sections 25 & 26 and 35 & 36
to the 1/4 section post between Sections 35 & 36.
