Required to part off 22 acres of land by a line running parallel to A B, as seen in the accompanying diagram between the line of lots B H, and the Railroad. Scale of diagram 2 chains to one inch.

From the recorded survey of the tract C B D F, we derive the location of B. since by rule $K S = S B$ and all in the same straight line.

1st We assumed the point 10 in the line of lots eight chains North of B, and ran the trial line (c b) 32.06 chains to the Railroad parallel to A B.

A B by measure = 2409 chains

$$1^{st} \quad \frac{32.06 \times 2409}{2} \times 8 = 22.46 \text{ Acres being } \frac{1}{4} \text{ of an acre too much.}$$

2nd Produce the sides c B and b A, till they meet in F and find C F.

$$3^{rd} \quad \frac{32.06}{2409 - 2409} \times 8 = 32.18 \quad \text{or } 32.18 - 8 = 24.18 = B F$$

We now have two sides of the Triangle A B F given to find the area etc. In this survey the angle A B F will not usually vary from a right angle.

$$A B F = \frac{2409 \times 24.18}{2} = 291,248.1 \text{ sq. chains.}$$

3rd To the area of the Triangle A B F, add the 22.46 sq. chains required to set off North of the line A B. Let X Y indicate the dividing line and then by similar triangles we have $291,248 \times 2.20 = 511,248 = X Y F$.

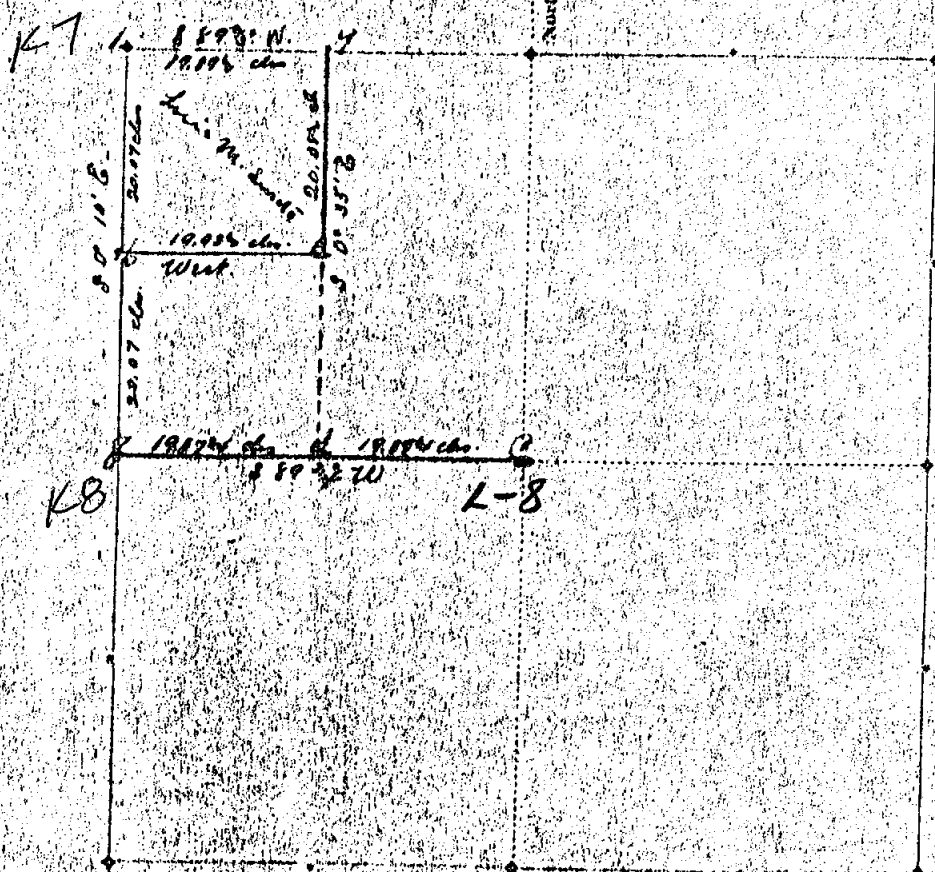

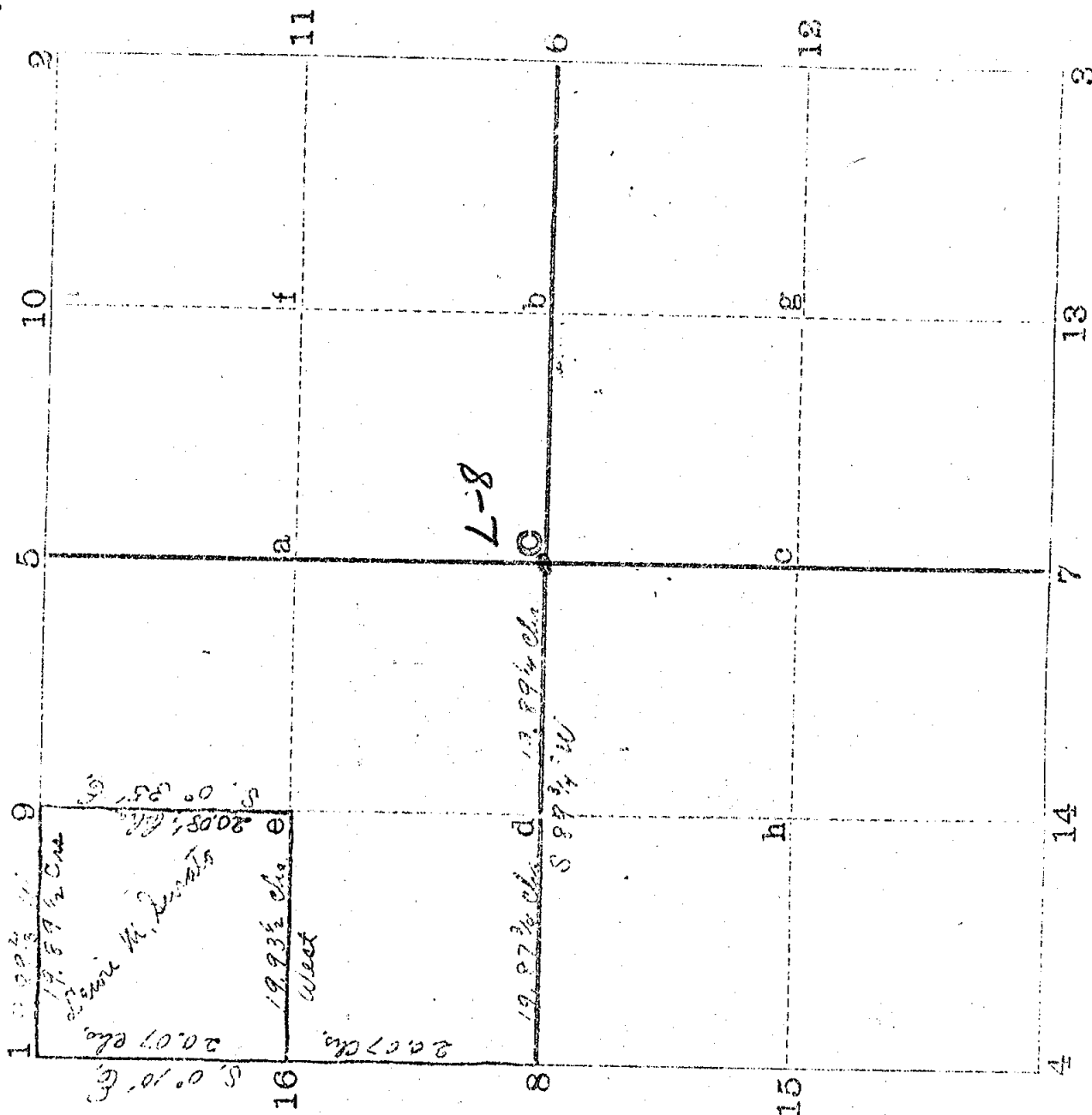

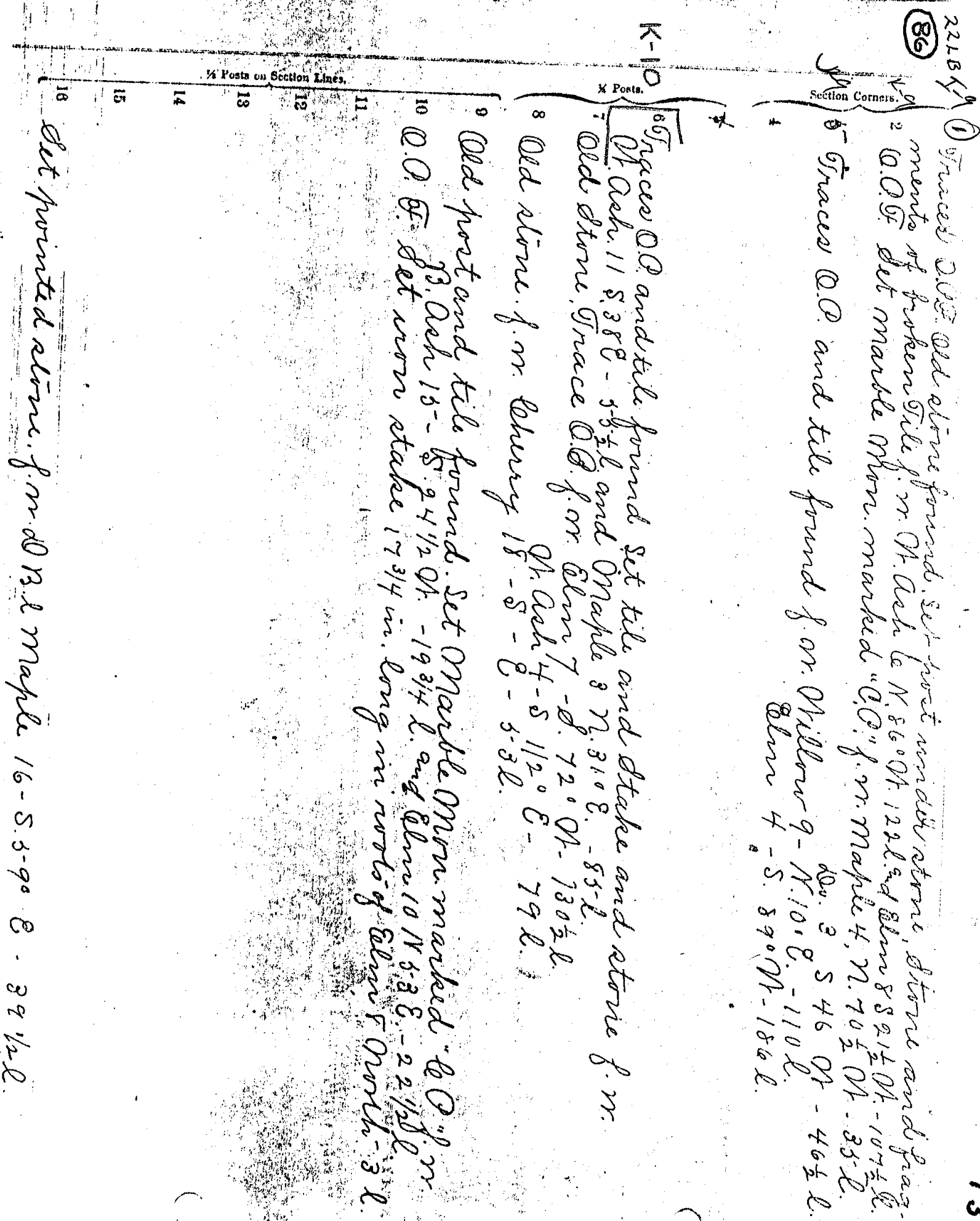
