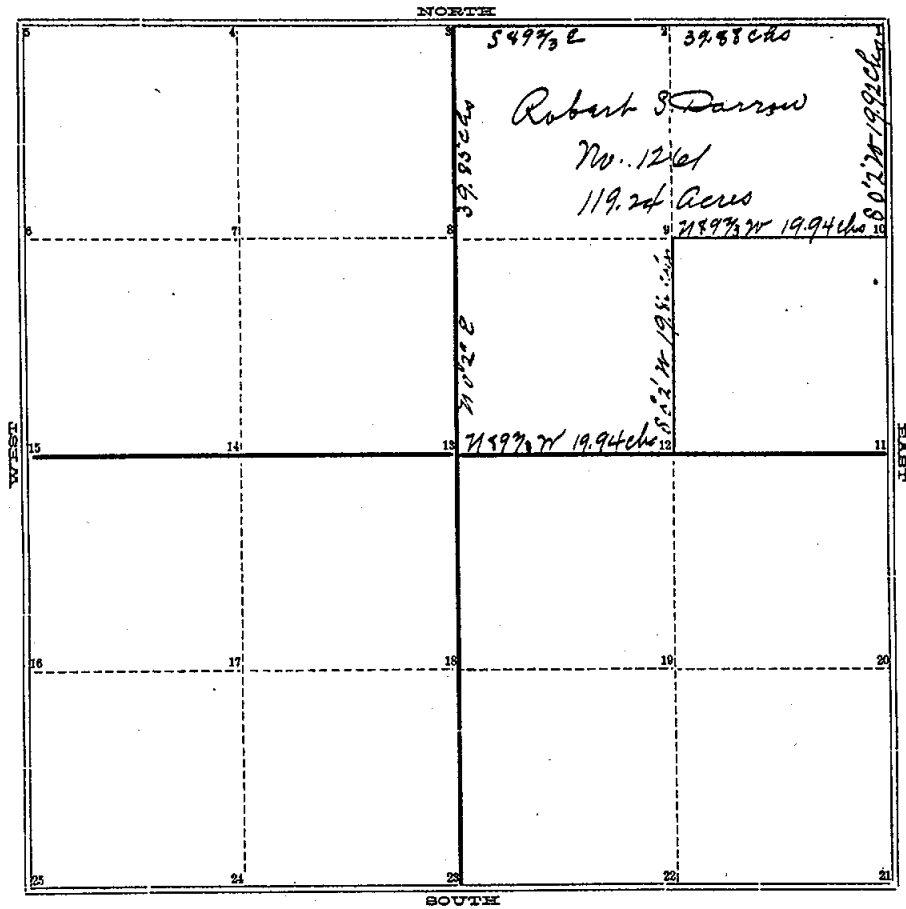
TOWN Three NORTH, RANGE Two West, MERIDIAN OF MICHIGAN.

Survey of the north half of the south west quarter of section No. 25 in township No. Three North of Range No. Two West. Beginning at "15" the quarter post as represented in the accompanying plat being a B. Oak about 8 inches diameter corner line and running thence $S 89^{\circ} 42' E$ 40.06 chs on the quarter post line to "13" the center of the section. Witnesses B. Oak 12 inches $S 46^{\circ} \frac{1}{2}' W$ 11 links & Elm 14 inches $S 58^{\circ} \frac{1}{2}' W$ 3 $\frac{1}{2}$ links. Thence south $0^{\circ} 4' W$ on north & south quarter line 20.00 chains to "18" a post. Witnesses Beech 8 in. diam. $N 76^{\circ} E$ 32 $\frac{3}{4}$ links & Beech 13 in. diam. $N 74^{\circ} 4' E$ 11 links. Thence $N 89^{\circ} 34' W$ 3.33 chains to "27" to the center of the state road leading from Lansing to Mason. Thence continued $N 89^{\circ} 34' W$ 36.50 chs to "16" the section line. No witness. Thence $N 0^{\circ} 15' W$ on section line 19.92 chs to the place of beginning. Also to find the quantity of land east of the state road aforesaid beginning at "27" the center of said road then following the center $N 23^{\circ} \frac{2}{3}' W$ 4.22 chs to an angle, thence $N 32^{\circ} \frac{1}{2}' W$ 12.65 chs to an angle, thence $N 12^{\circ} \frac{3}{4}' E$ 2.71 chs. to an angle, thence $N 46^{\circ} \frac{1}{4}' E$ 2.93 chs to "26" a post in the quarter line. Thence $S 89^{\circ} 42' E$ on said quarter line 12.27 chs to "13" a post in the center of the section aforesaid. Thence $S 0^{\circ} 4' W$ on the north and south quarter line 20.00 chs to "18" a post. Thence $N 89^{\circ} 34' W$ 3.33 chs to the place of beginning. 17.6 Acres. 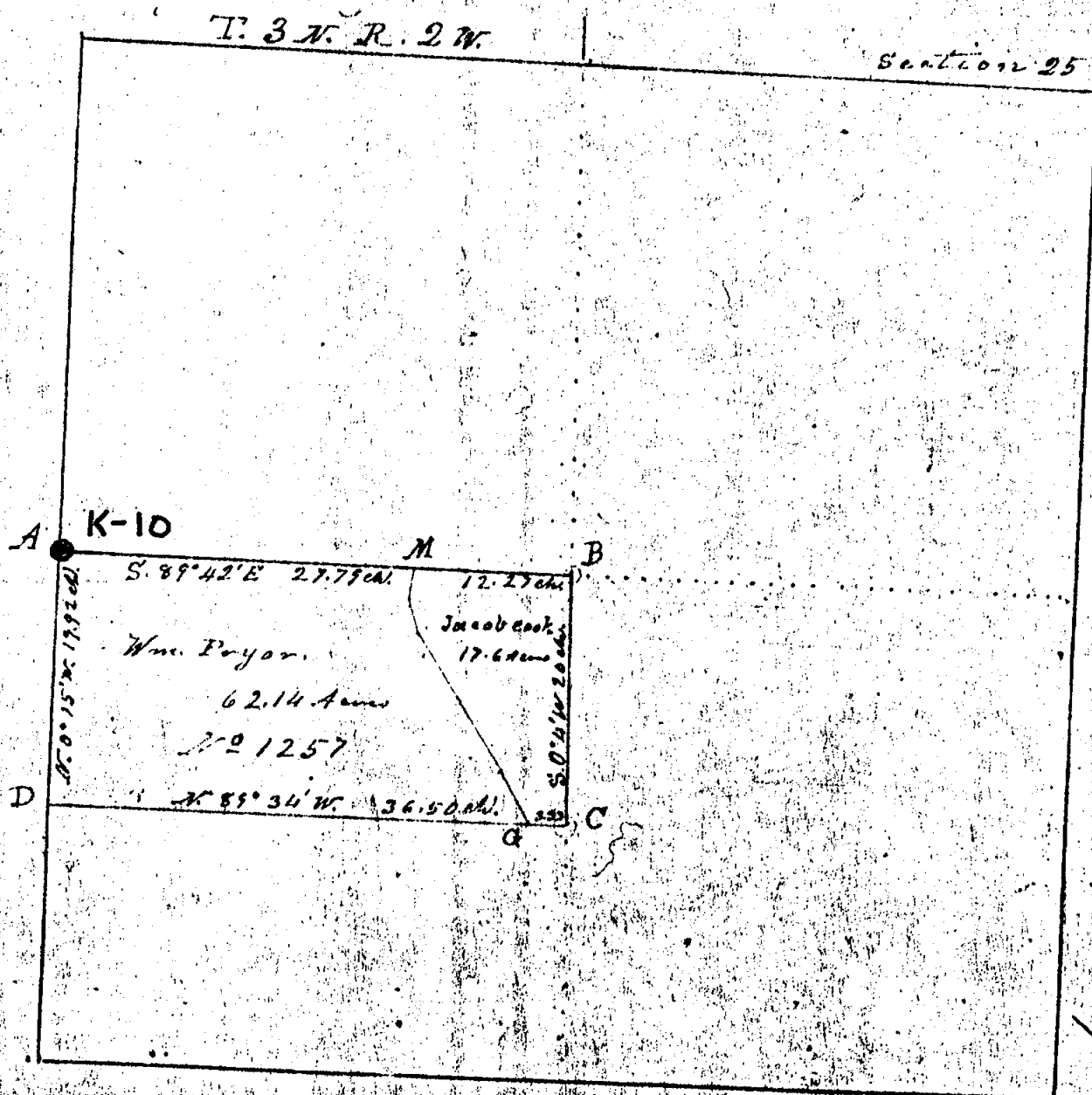

Survey of the north half of the South-west quarter of Section No. Twenty-five in Township No. Three north of Range No. Two west. Beginning at (A) the Quarter Post as represented in the accompanying Plat, being a Blk. Ash about 8 in. diameter corner Tree & running thence S. 89° 42' E. 40.06 chains to the Quarter line to (B) the center of the section. Witness Blk. Ash 12 in. diam. S. 66° 1/2' W. 11 links & Cross 14 inches S. 54° 1/2' W. 3 1/4 links; thence S. 0° 1/2' W. on North & South Quarter line 20.00 chains to (C) a Post, Witness Birch 4 in. diam. N. 76° E. 32 1/4 links & Branch 13 inches diam. S. 24 3/4° E. 11 links; thence N. 89° 34' W. 3.33 chains to (D) the center of the State Road leading from Lansing to Moscow, thence continued N. 89° 34' W. 36.50 chains to (E) the section line. 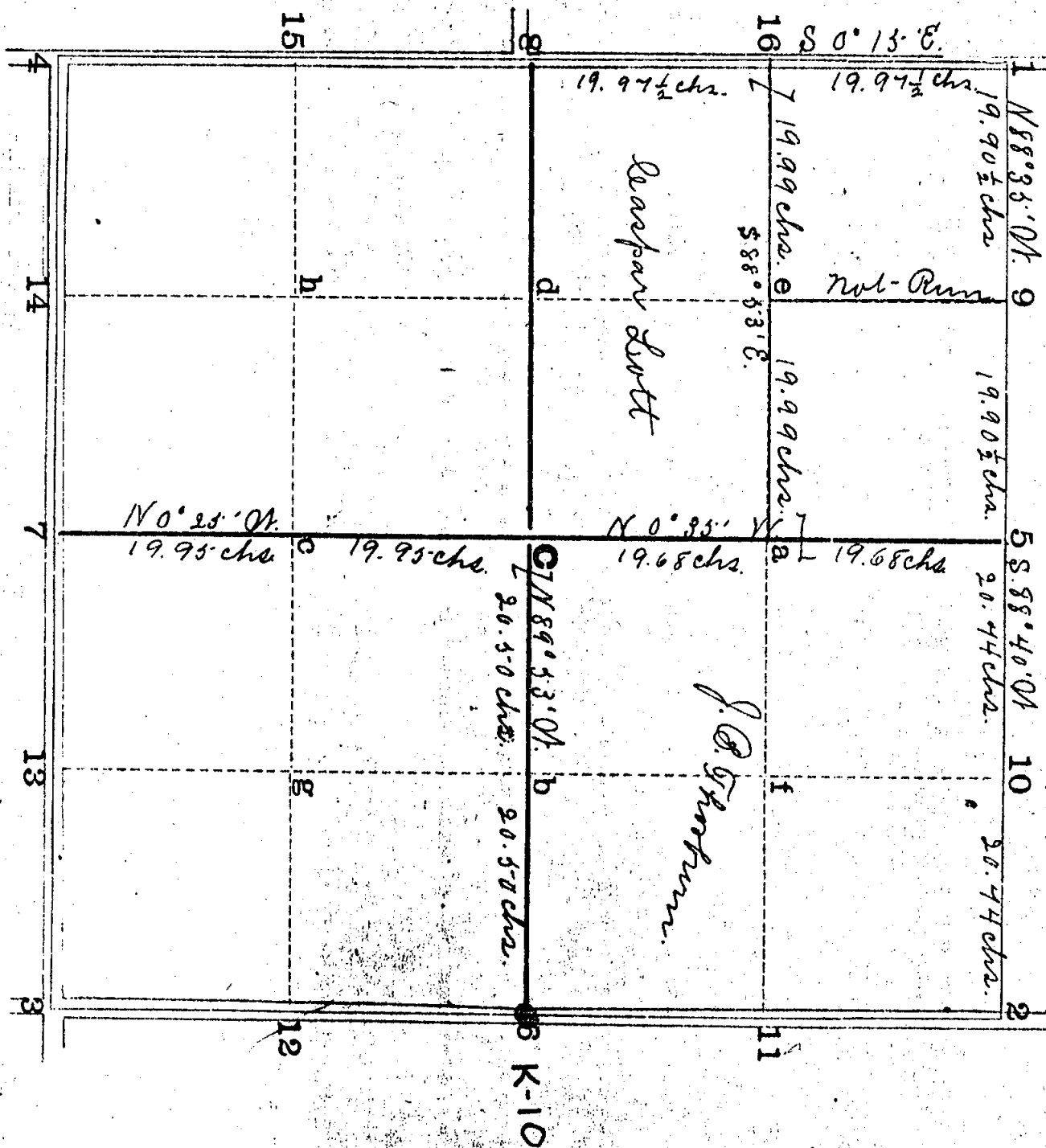

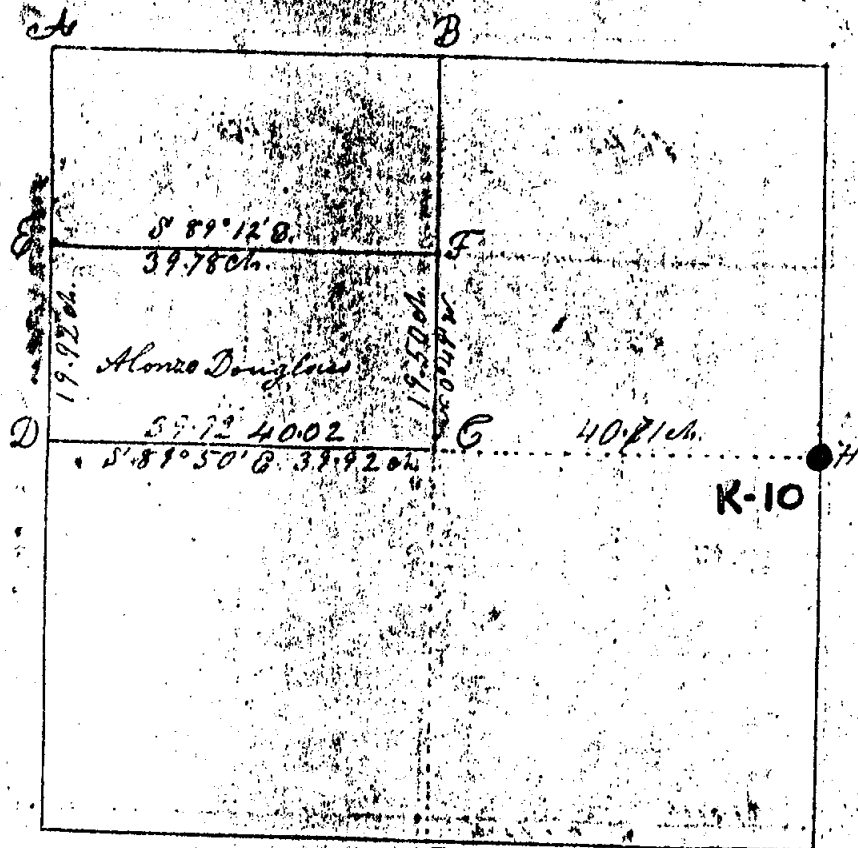
