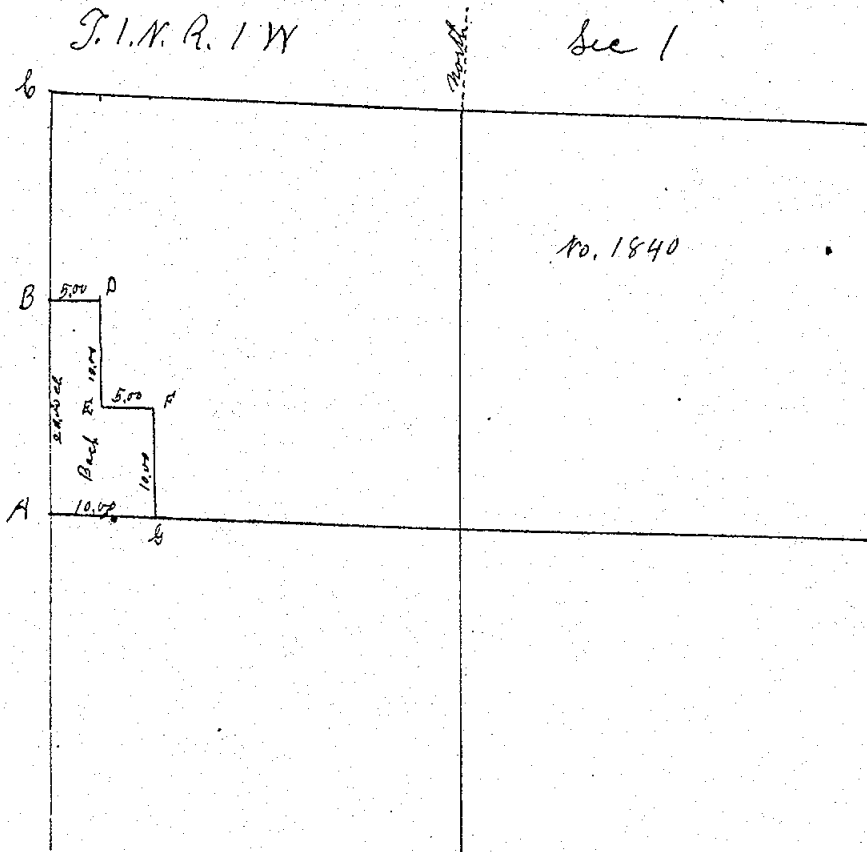

Survey of the N & S $\frac{1}{4}$ line of Sec. 5 of Ingham made April 29th 1896 for M.D. Robinson & others

The south $\frac{1}{4}$ post A was set midway between section corners upon a transit line and the Post b was perpetuated with a stone by J. J. Brown which stone was found.
