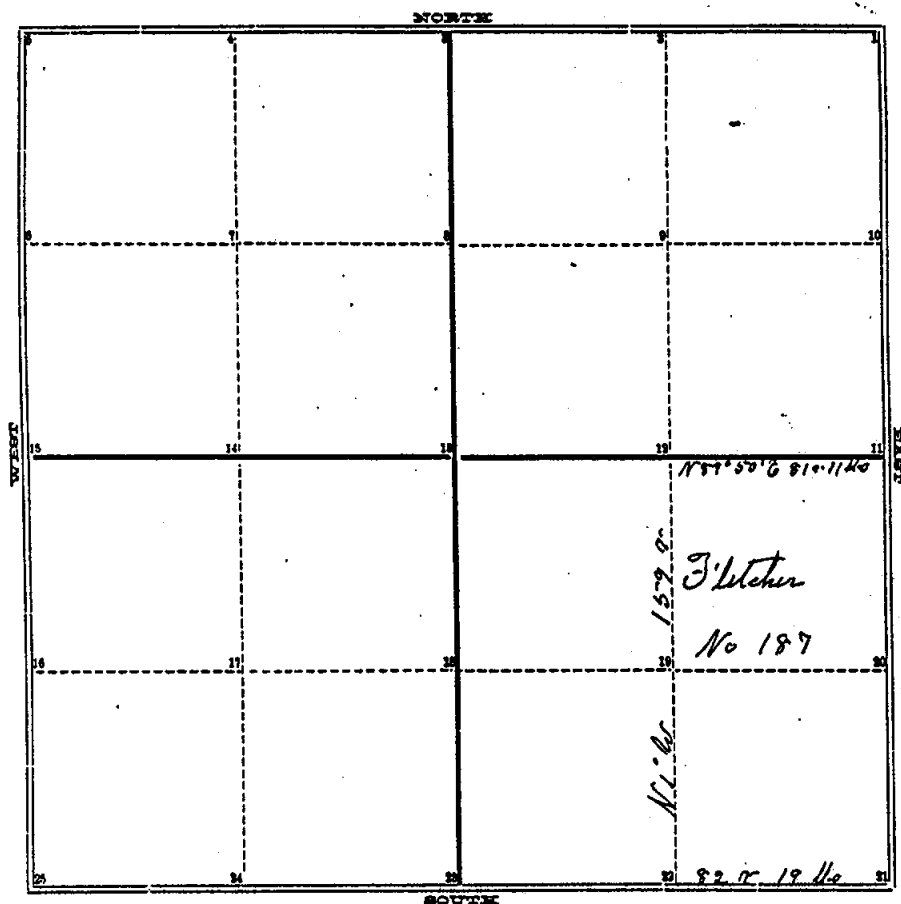

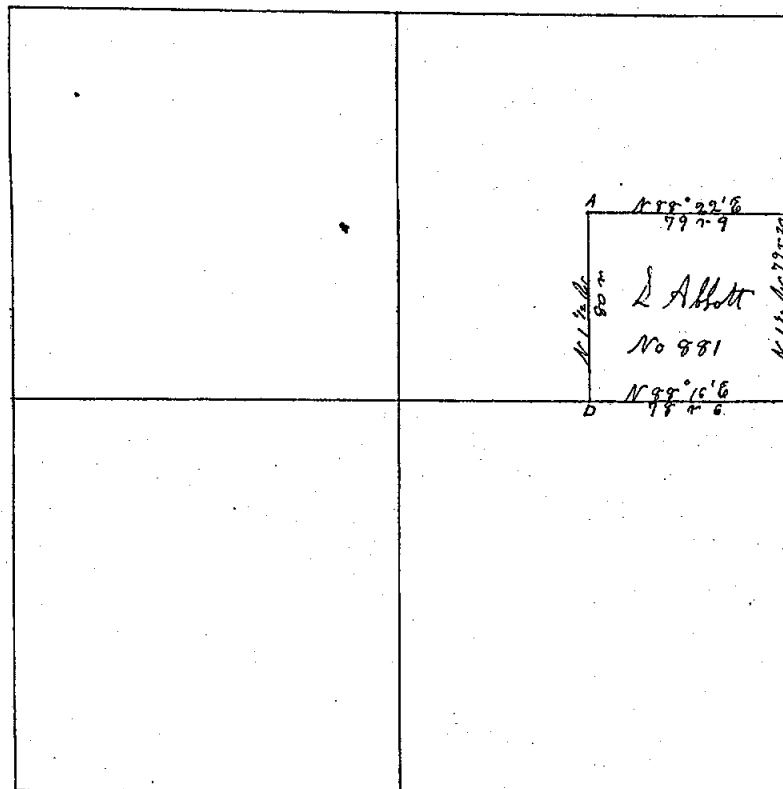

Note: The Section corner E was lost and as the MS field notes show that each township boundary line was established on a due North and South or East and West line and a corner set at each 40 chains (except the last half mile of each line) and consequently at equal distances apart being alternately Section and Quarter Section corners and in this case the corner E should be and is hereby reestablished in a right line and equal distant between the last quarter posts of Sections 13 and 24

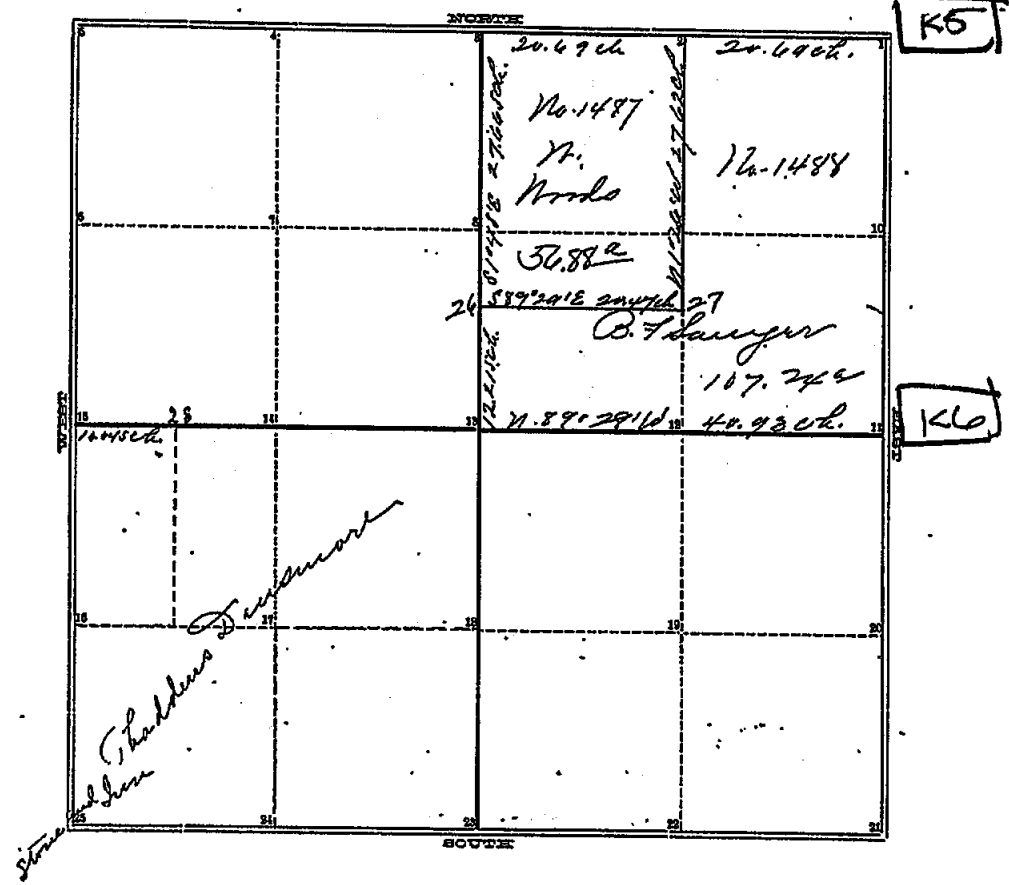
Note at No 31. This monument corner was removed by A Jackson & by neglect was nearly lost. but by measurement and careful search was found beneath the surface where the Post had been broken off and became quite obscure. New witness trees were marked as follows
 Elm 4 inches diameter bears $N 48^{\circ} W 37\frac{1}{2}$ links Elm 16 inches diameter bears $S 24^{\circ} E 69$ links
