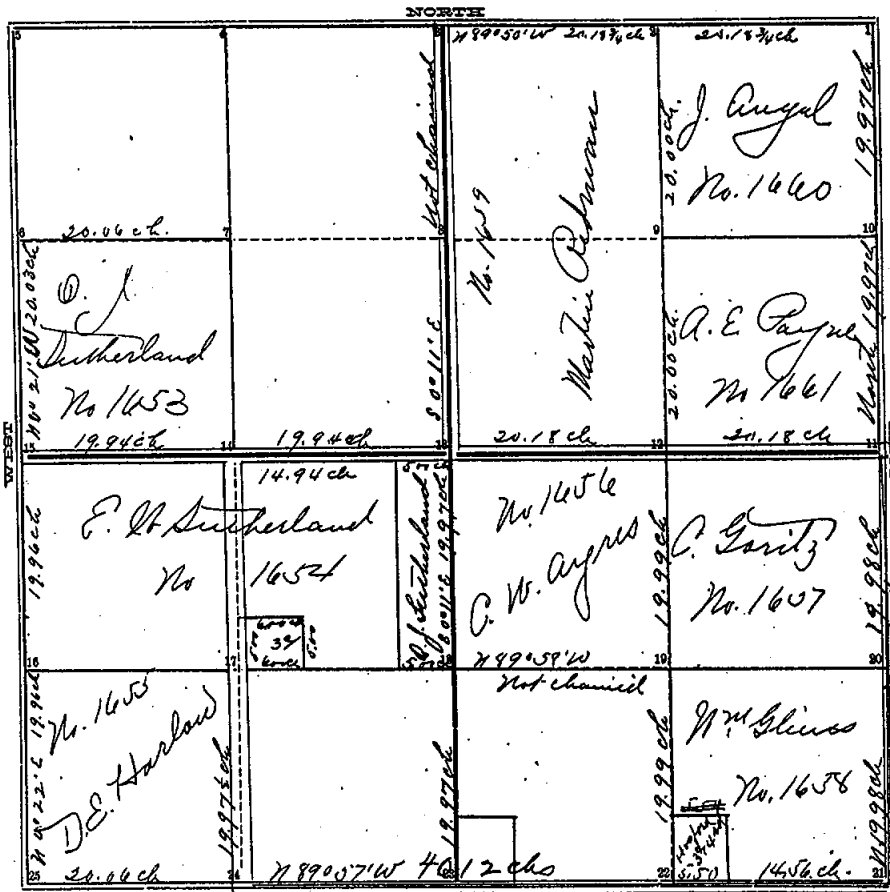

The corners (5), (3), (1), and (11) were found by the U. S. Survey. (2) was found and perpetuated by W. H. Raper. or rather the accompanying corner in T 4 N R 1 W (see page 37) and by T. J. Brown (See page 102) (15) was found in the survey of section (36) by which was supposed to be the original witness tree. The stump was standing and the other tipped over. At (15) the first quarter lot was a stone said to be in the place of the first. The witnesses were extinct (23) was located in line and equal distance between the section corners (25) and (21)

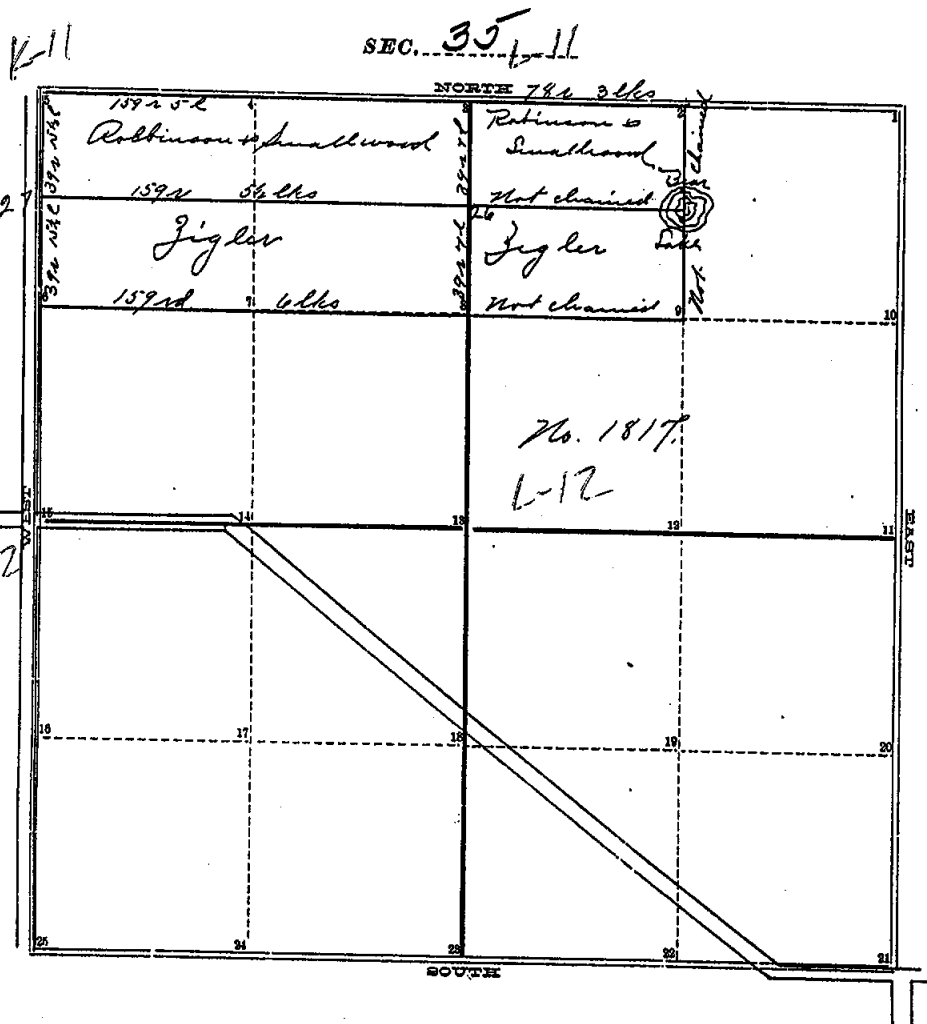

Survey No 1817 was made to ascertain the exact location of the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Section No 35 and the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. 35 and the division of the north half of the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec. No 35 and the equal division of the N.W. $\frac{1}{4}$ of the N.E. $\frac{1}{4}$ of Sec 35. The corners in the plat that are lettered are located by measurement and corrected lines. The corners are described in the note below the plat. The corners are in Bear Lake and the one south of it was not located nor the N & S line measured but except in account of ~~water~~ the swamp being wholly inaccessible. The survey was made May 28th 24th & 28th 1890

On Mar. 26, 1909 I retraced parts of the above survey in order to establish line 26-27. The corner 27 was found as recorded above by McCreary. Corner 26 was gone and in order to establish it I ran the line 3-8 and established 26 midway and on the true line between 3 and 8 setting a Bitternut stake f.w. a R. Oak 12" 3-E 45 lks and R. Oak 6" 3-W 17 lks. Line stakes were also set every 20 rods from 27 east just 26 to the bank of Bear Lake.
