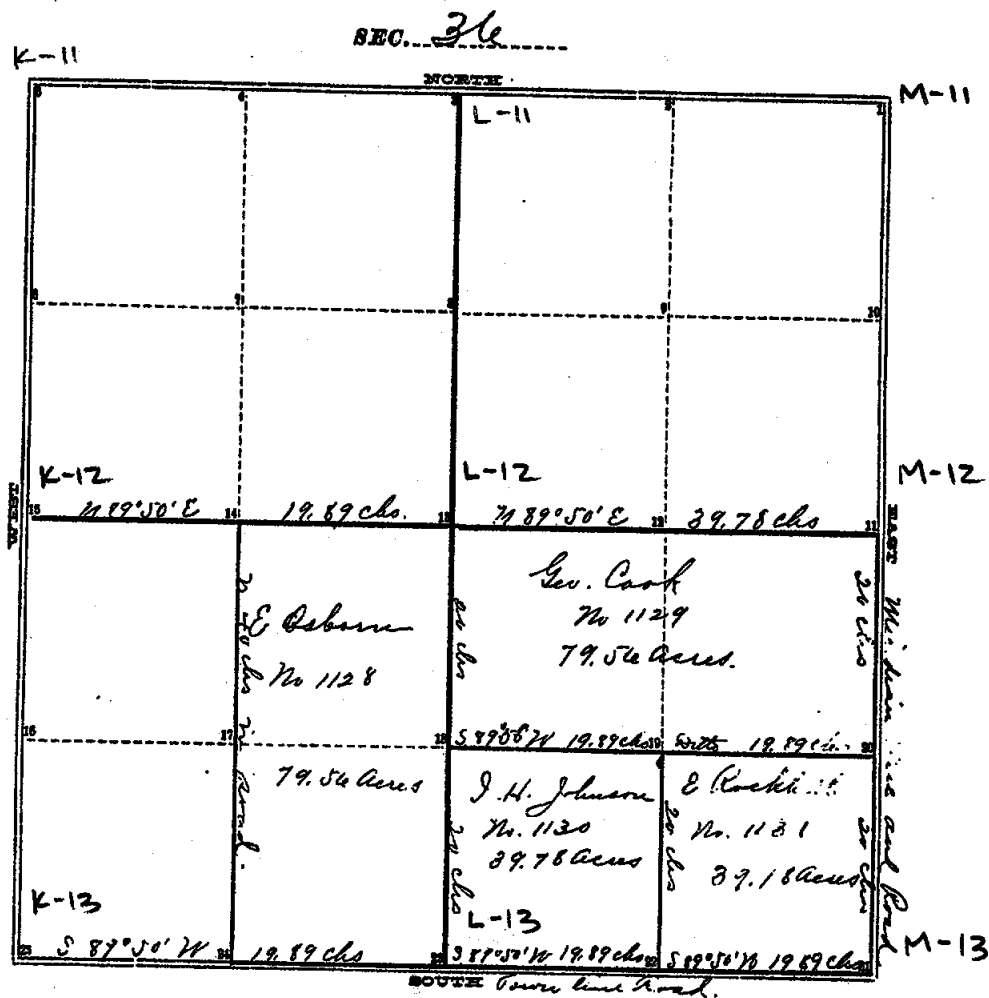

TOWN Four NORTH, RANGE One West, MERIDIAN OF MICHIGAN.Run and recorded Feb. 25th 1863

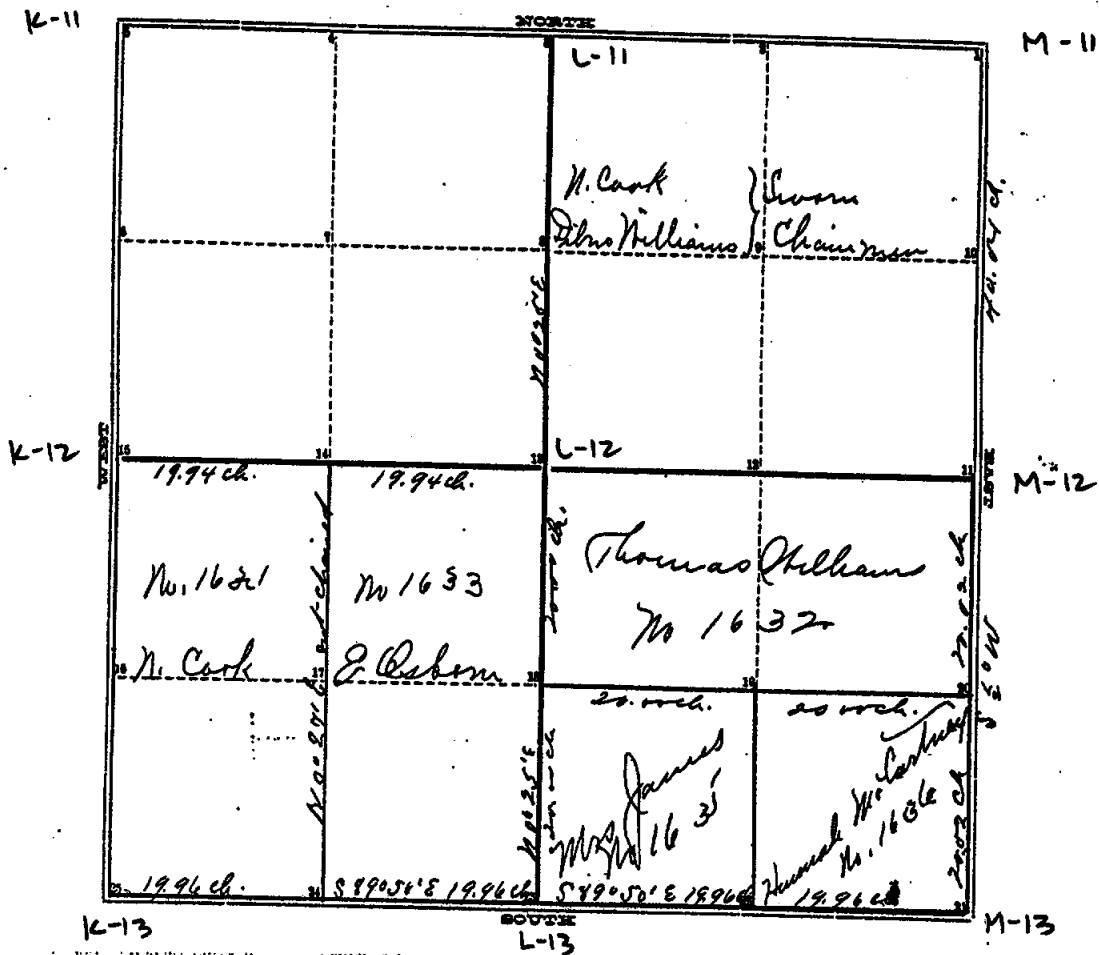
Survey of the south half of section 36 T4 N of R1W. Commencing at the south east corner of said section (on the meridian) represented by "21" in the plat. Thence S 87° 50' West 19.89 chains to "22", from which a ~~stump~~ 20 inches diameter bears N 10 3/4° W, 44 links and a ~~stump~~ 5 inches N 51 1/2° E, 70 links. Thence 19.89 chains to "23" quarter post no witness, then to "24", 19.89 chains. No wit. A big stone planted in center of the road each way. Thence North 60.00 chs to "14" from which a sugar 4 inches diameter bears S 61° E 74 links and a Beech 20 inches S 57° W, 51 1/2 links. Thence N 89° 50' E 19.89 chains to "13" from which a beech 16 inches bears S 63 1/2° W 17 links and a sugar 24 inches N 31° E 15 3/4 links. Thence ditto 39.78 ~~back~~ chains to "11" No witness except the old stumps (a stake drove down). Thence south on the Meridian line 20.00 chs to "20", from which a B. Ash stump 20 inches W 85 1/2° N 8 links. Thence S 87° 50' W 19.89 chains to "19" from which a Beech 6 inches bears S 10° E 37 links and Beech 8 inches S 66 3/4° W, 41 links. Thence ditto 19.89 chains to "18" from which a Beech 20 inches bears N 27° W, 10 1/2 links and Beech 6 inches S 33 1/2° E, 3 1/2 links. Thence south 20 chains to "23". Then run the line "22" to "19" and "20" to "21". Chain bearers sworn Evers H. Hoderick and Wm. Johnson. Run by the true meridian 2 3/4° E by Wm. H. Rayner C. Surveyor.

P.S. The corners "14" and "13" may not be on a line with "11" and west quarter post when it is established. So they are subject to being rectified. Parties do not want to be to the expense. It came out on the north side of road. Could not make a permanent survey. This subject to being rectified. J. H. Rayner C. Surveyor.

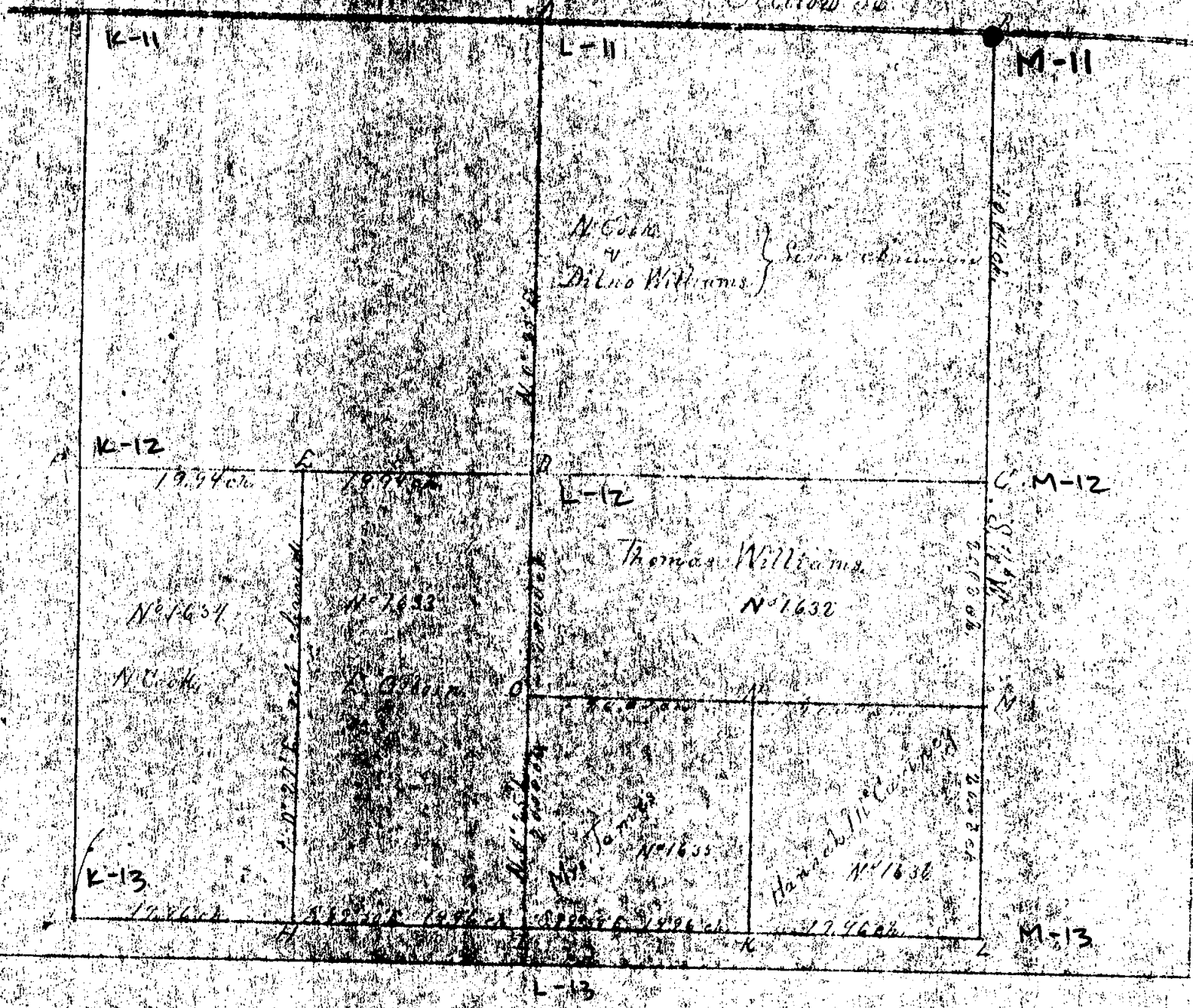

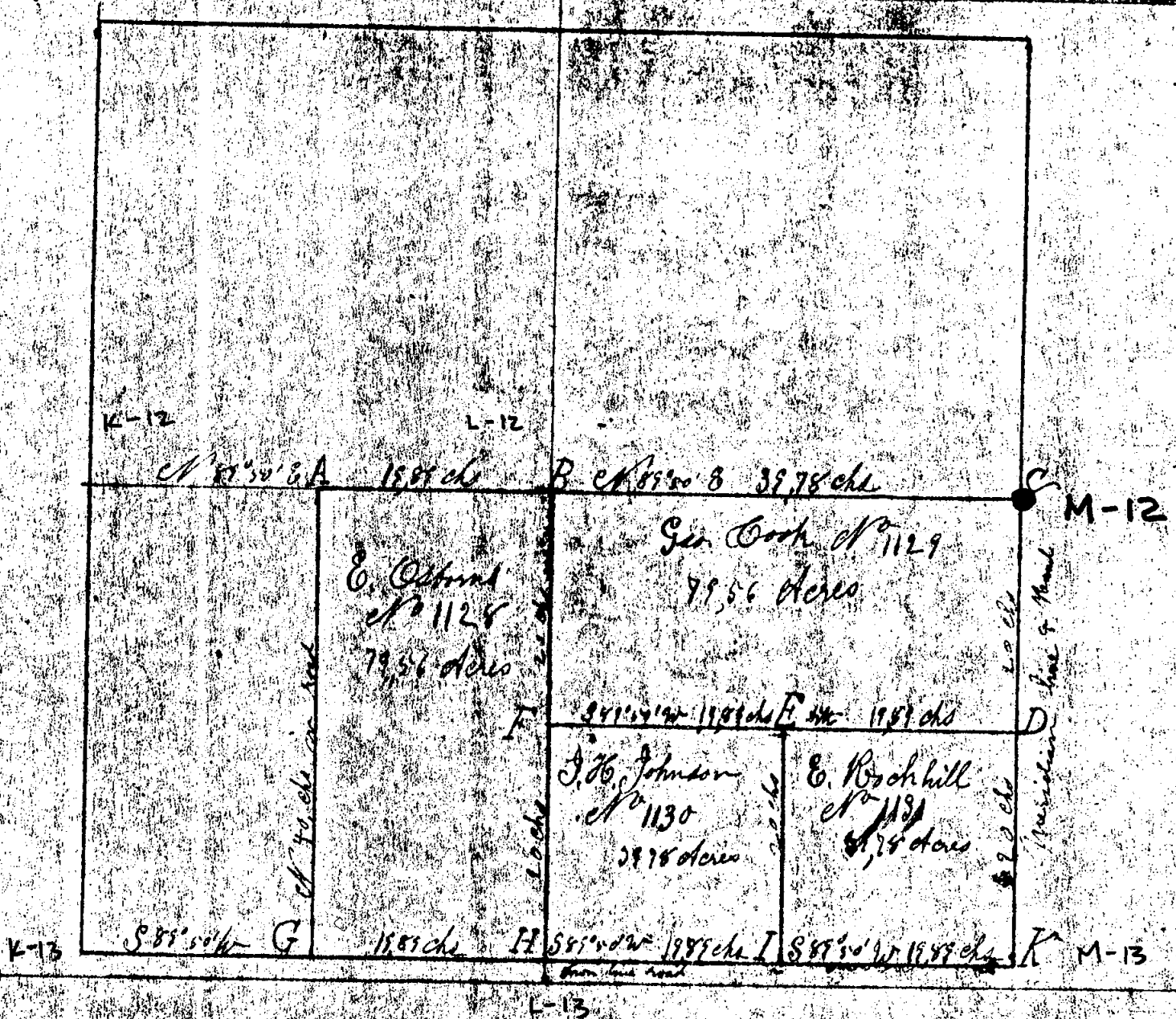

Revised & Re-recorded February 25th 1883

Survey of south half of section thirty two Town 4 N. of Range 1 W. Commencing at the South East corner of said section (on the Meridian) represented by K in the plat running thence South 89° 50' West 19.59 chs to I from which a Sugar 20 inches diameter bears N 10° 40' W 44 lbs & Sugar 5 in. N 51° 40' E 70 lbs Thence 19.59 chs to H quarter cor. of section. Thence to G 18.89 chs to a big stone planted in center of the road each way. Thence North 40 chs to A from which a Sugar 4 inches diameter bears S 61° E 74 lbs to B 20 in. S 57° W 51 lbs. Thence N 89° 50' E 19.59 chs to B from which a Beech 16 in bears S 67° W 17 lbs & Sugar 24 in N 51° E 15 lbs. Thence S 89° 50' E 19.59 chs to C. No witness except the old stump (stone above down) Thence South on the Meridian line 20 chs to D from which a Beech 16 in bears S 57° W 51 lbs Thence South 89° 50' W 19.59 chs to E from which Beech 6 in bears S 10° E 57 lbs & Beech 8 in S 66° W 41 lbs Thence S 89° 50' E 19.59 chs to F from which a Beech 20 in bears N 27° W 10 lbs & Beech 6 in S 57° E 51 lbs Thence South 20 chs to H. Then run the line I to E & D to K. Then bears ^{Sum} Ears Woodworth & John Johnson. Run by the true Meridian 2 1/4 E By W. H. Wagner Co Surveyor

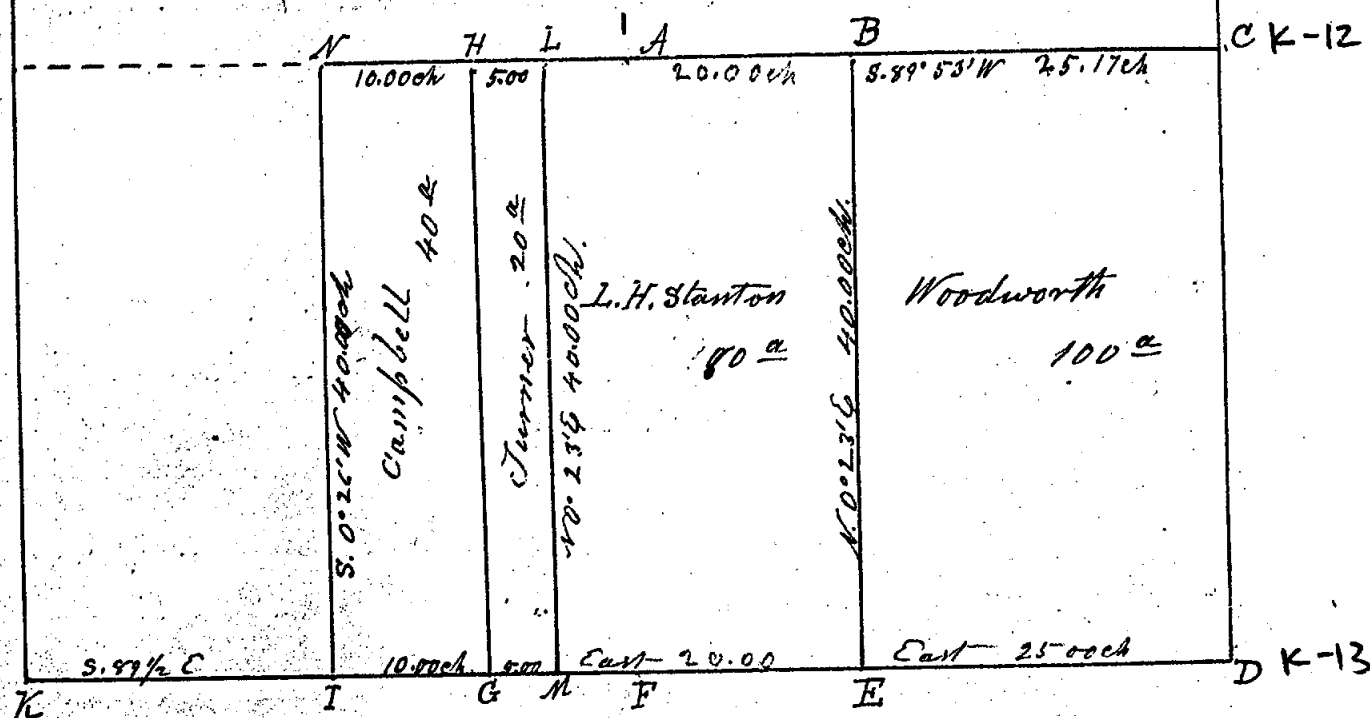

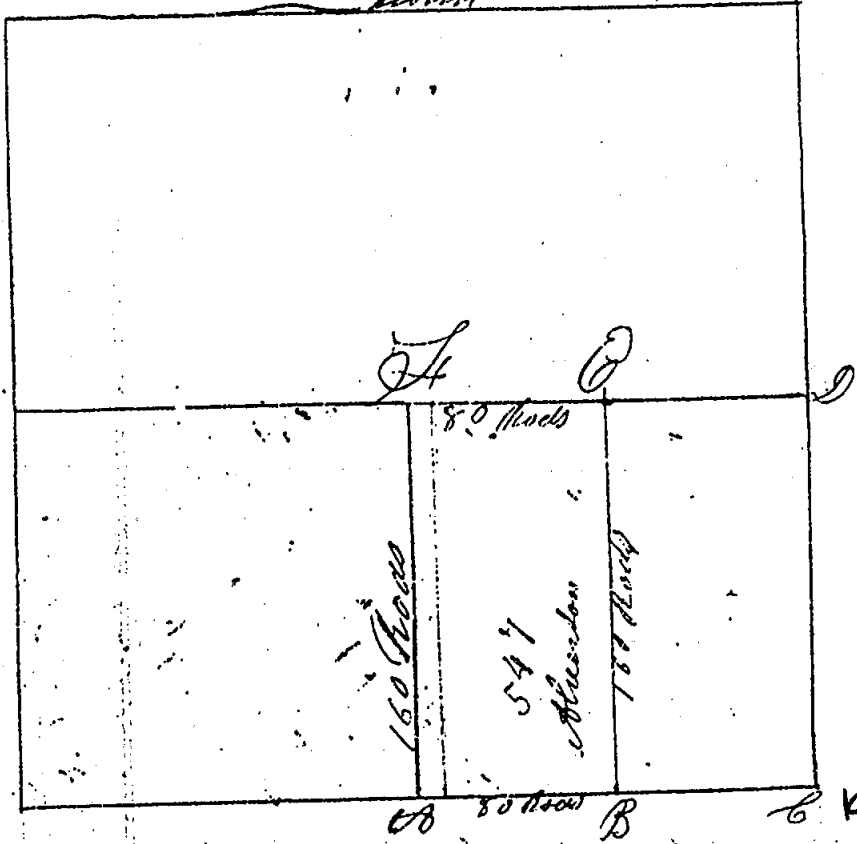
