The object of this survey was to locate the 8 1/4 post of Sec 32. W. Oak & the 1/4 post of Sec 32 stockbridge.

Beginning at the SE cor Sec 32 E-13 O.F.F. thence N 89° W 20.04 ch. remains to O.P.F. Set post; iron rod & stone pin. W. Oak 1 1/2 in. N 31° E. 20 3/4 l & W. Oak 24 in. N 88° E 5 1/4 l.

Thence on in same course 20.04 ch. set the post gas pipe & pin W. Oak 30 in D-13 N 31° W. 32 l & W. Oak 24 in S. 88° E 4 5/8 l.

Proved up by lining and measurement from creek bed and also from SW cor Sec 32 W. Oak. The witnesses of which are still good and the SW cor Sec 32 stockbridge C-1 (STOCK-BRIDGE)

O.P.F. Also old unrecorded survey on the 1/4 Sec 5 old 1/4 post found and set in road survey. All of which confirm the W line but would not allow the 1/4 post of Sec 5 to set for D-1 (STOCK-BRIDGE) enough to the west but I considered the survey had been accepted as long as the disturbed ground set at 1/4 post of Sec 5 D-1 (STOCK-BRIDGE) at an appropriate distance between the W. Oak 1/4 post & the recognized 1/4 post on D-13 the north line of Sec 5 which was 2.46 ch. west from the 8 1/4 post of Sec 32 D-13

W. Oak Post set from shop. Post W. Oak 30 in N. 25° E. 30 l & back to 8 1/4 8 1/4 E 254 l.

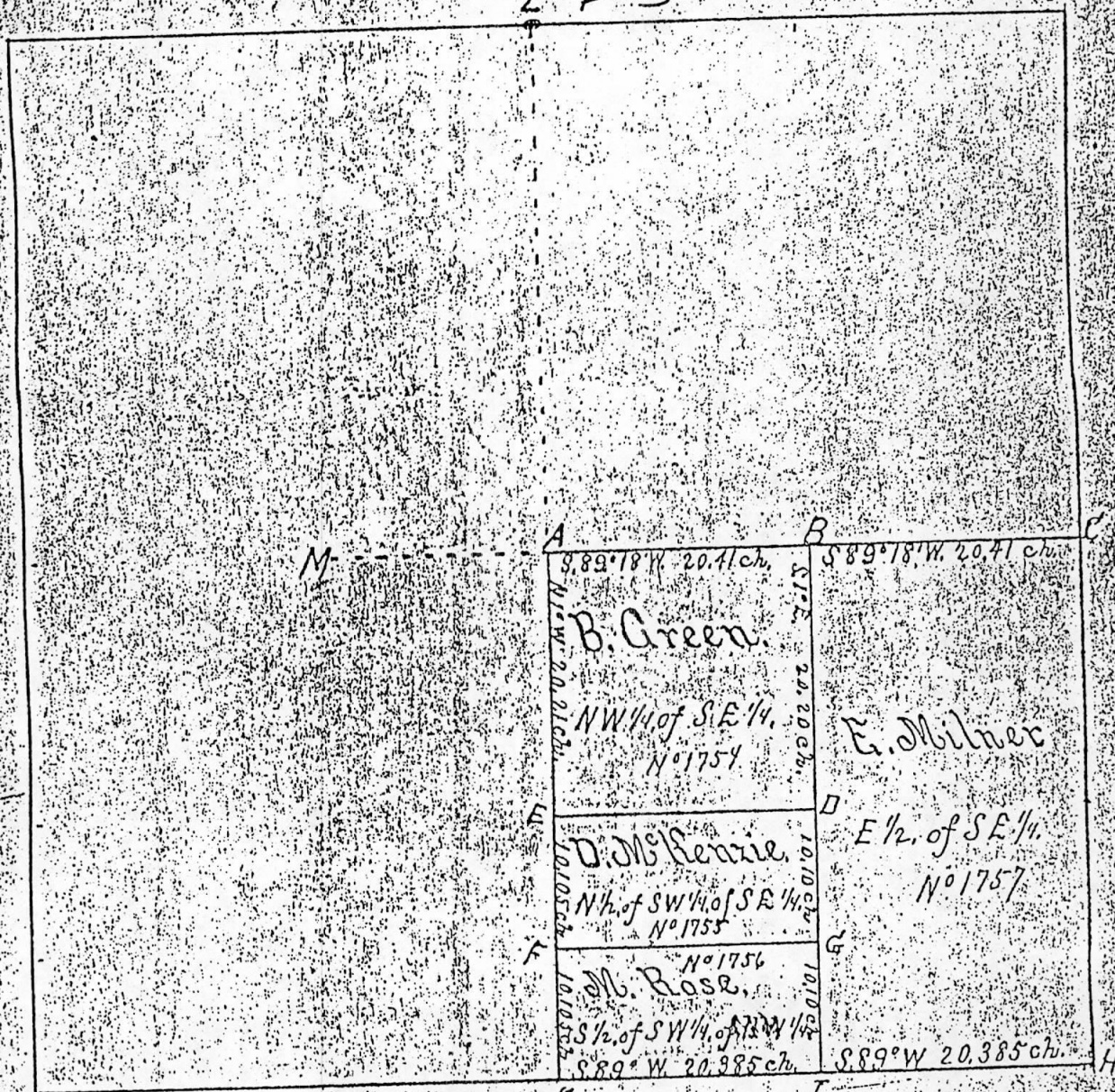

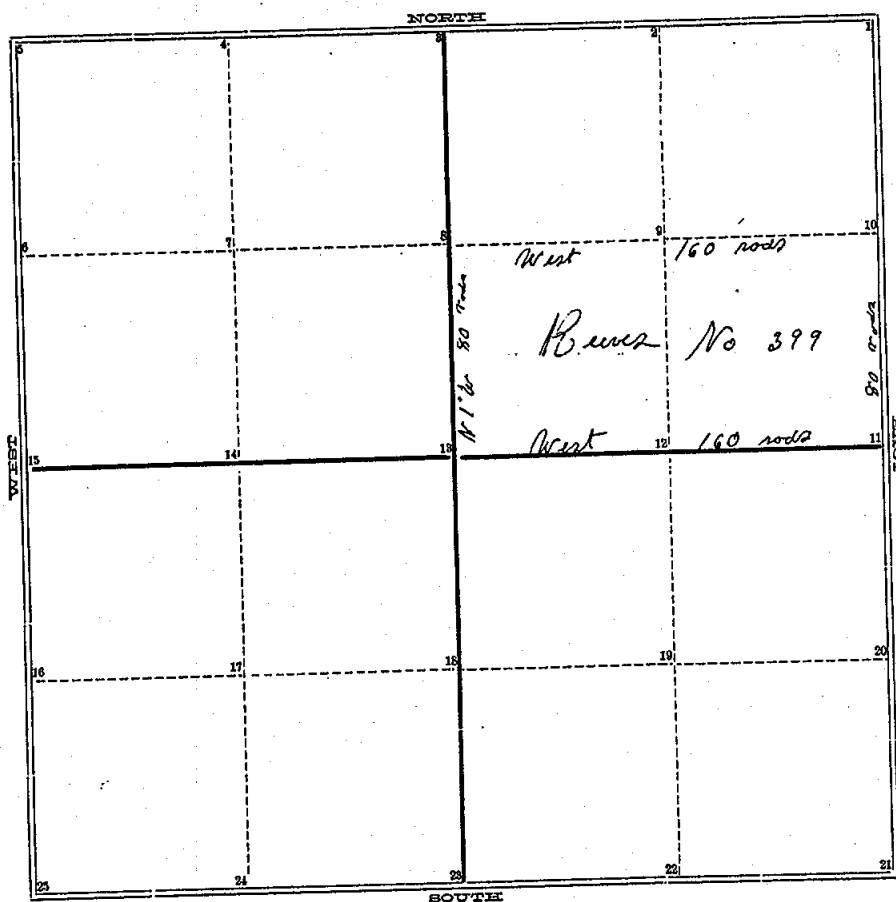

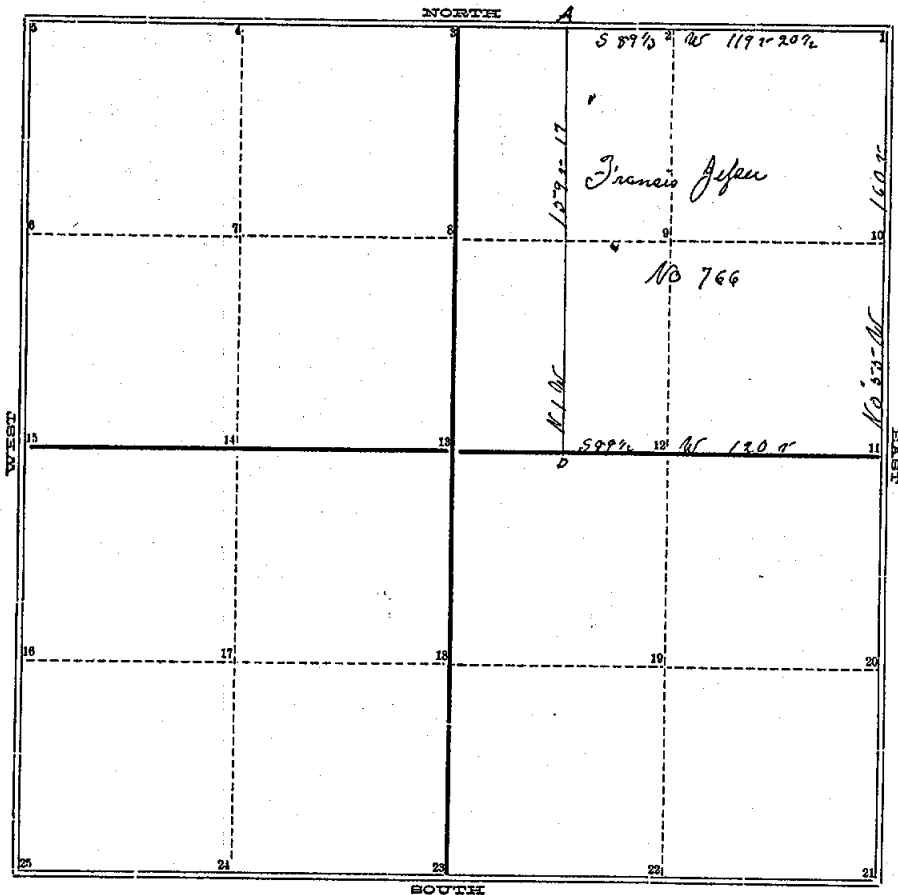
