Survey of the Whole of Section 27 of T 3 N R 1 E. Wheatfield
 In the first instance it was only intended to survey the SE 1/4 of the Section but it was found that as fences were built at 1840 & 1875 chains in the South 1/2 mile and in the North 1/2 mile it was only 38.19 ch. which was to much of a discrepancy to be accepted as final and to prove satisfactory the condition of things would involve the survey of the entire Section the work up to this point was done Nov 21 at 22 and 23 the 1899 and was delayed and a petition circulated for the survey of the Whole Section which was begun again December 19 and finished Dec 22 and 1899.
The Section corners were all found and satisfactory to all parties the South 1/4 Post was established in right line and equal distance between the Section corners the North 1/4 post was perpetuated by Monument in A survey of Section 28 and is satisfactory to all parties the NW corner was found in fact and all right the N 1/4 post is accepted by any one interested and the N.E. corner was found by one of the Ill & Government Portnefs men and the east 1/4 post was the difficult problem to solve and to do this the natural conditions recited in the U.S. Survey were made the base of measurement the bed of the river 78 lbs the N of the 1/4 post is plainly visible and using that as a base it was found to be only 1/2 mile from the center and a search in it much revealed a hole which went straight down into the clay and kept getting smaller until it disappeared and was plainly the mark of a stake and a Sap Tree was set on this place and to prove
