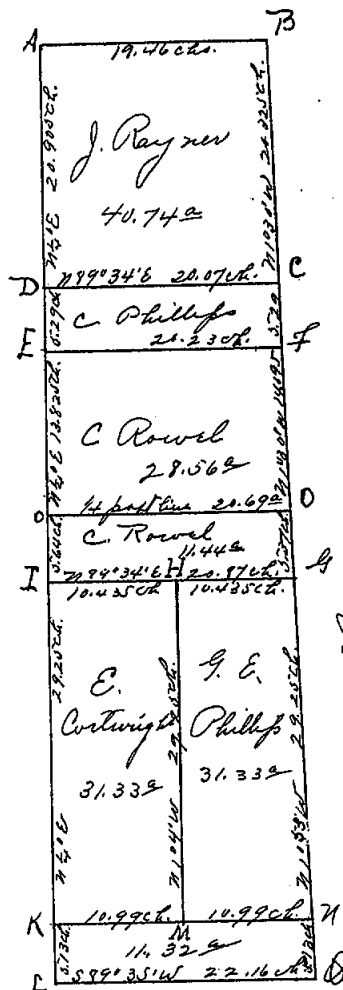

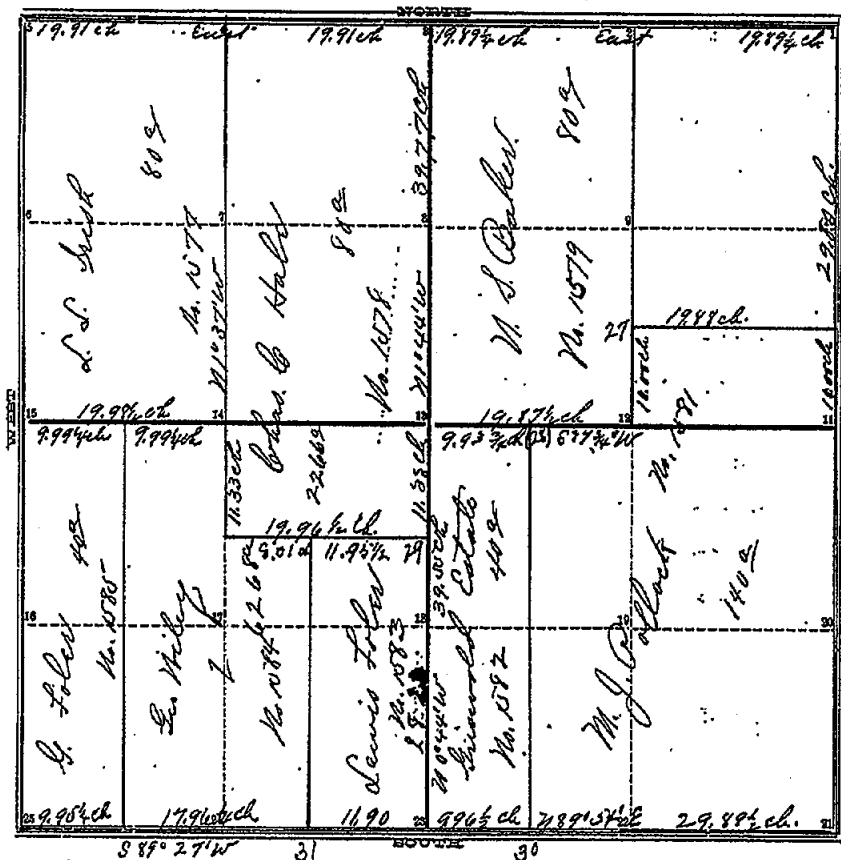

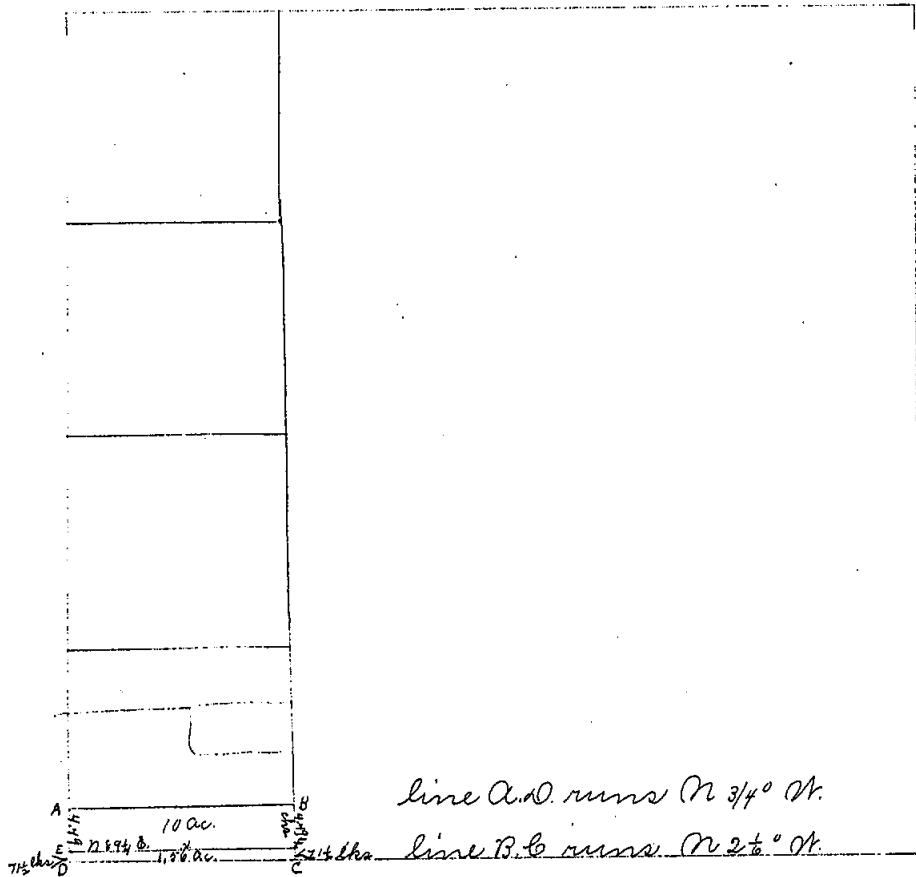
Survey of section Twenty nine in Township No Three North of Range No One East as shown by the plat the scale of which is 13 chains to one inch by which all the corners are described by letters referring to the same, and the distance given on all lines measured. The east half of the south west quarter was divided thus 22.66 acres being set off on the north end, then 22.68 acres from the west side of what remained leaving 34.66 acres more or less in 1883 in compliance with the deeds thereof.

Note: At the corner (1) I find ² stakes I saw one made by W. H. Rayner, the other claimed by Mr. Kent to be the original corner and I am of the opinion that he is right and my reasons are these that the original survey makes the west half of section Twenty nine 40.08 chains and the east half of section 29, 40.03 chains or difference of 5 links. Now according to Mr. Rayner the west half of section 28 16 links too long and the east half of section 29, 16 links too small. When the corner noted in this record makes the sides agree with the original.

This survey is a subdivision of the area embraced by lines St. N, L.O, St. R, and N.O of Survey No. 1489 into the South 1.56 acres and North 10 acres.

The subdivision line was determined to be a line running parallel to line L.O above mentioned and through a point $7\frac{1}{2}$ links North of said line L.O.

Magnetic variation of 10' West was allowed.

At the corner E. I find two stakes one made by W. H. Baynes and the other claimed by Mr. Baynes to be the original corner, and I am of the opinion that the one made by Mr. Baynes is the original corner, the original survey made by W. H. Baynes 4000 ch. and the E. half of 22.66 ch. a difference of 16 links. Now according to Mr. Baynes the W. half of 22.66 ch. is 16 links too large and the E. half of 22.66 ch. is 16 links too small, which the corner set in this record makes both sides agree with the original.
