Survey of the whole of Section 27 of T & N R / E Wheatfield
In the first 1/4

I'm the first instance it was only intended to survey the SE 1/4 of the section but it was found that as fence was built it was 40.75 chains in the south 1/4 mile was in the NW mile it was only 38.19 ch which was to much of a discrepancy to accept as final and to prove satisfactorily the condition of things would require the survey of the entire section the work up to this point was done Nov 21 at 22 and 23 and 1897 and was signed and petition circulated for the survey of the whole section which was begun again December 19 and finished Dec 22 and 1899 The section corners receive all forms and satisfactory to all parties the South 1/4 Post was established in right line and equal distance between the section corners the West 1/4 post was perpetuated by Brown in a survey of section 28 and is satisfactory to all parties the NW corner was found in fact and all by the NW post is accepted by every one interested and the NE corner was found by one of the N O Government witness trees and the east 1/4 Post was the difficult problem to solve and to do this the natural conditions existed in the N O survey was a cross the base of measurement the bed of the ran 78 lbs N of the 1/4 post is plainly visible and using that as a base it was found to be only two links from the corner and a search in the mud revealed a hole which went straight down into the clay and kept getting smaller until it disappeared and was finding the marks of a stake and a 1 1/2 ft. was set in its place and to prove further the corner thus set it was chained south to the edge of the deep 12 chains from the N O survey and the 12 chains was about 10 feet from the line of the hard sand and chaining back to the O line line it came out exactly with the Iron line noted in the N O survey and also agreed exactly with the stone found at the center of the section and which had been always regarded as the section center and 12 chains set and continuing over D intersecting the east section line at C at the point where the stake hole was found which said point is to my mind unquestionably the original Government corner. The survey of the section was made from the written Petition of Thomas Lambert Charles Lord M D Bullin Charles Rindal Frank Allen Emily J and Mrs J C West and George Sadler. The survey of the section was made December 19, 20, 21 at 22 and 1899
