Upon review of excavation reports for A-3 Locke Township and M-3 Williamston Township, submitted by the Field Operations staff of the Ingham County Survey and Remonumentation Project, it appears as though the corner recorded by you in Liber 4 Page 204, Ingham County Land Corner Recordation Certificates as A-3 Locke Township may be M-3 Williamston Township. Our research on the two corners in question shows the following: 1) the General Land Office Field notes show that A-3 Locke is located 5 links (3.3') south of M-3 Williamston; 2) John McCreary, County Surveyor, set a gas pipe for M-3 Williamston on March 14 & 15, 1889 and used these witnesses: 2" Maple, S73E, 47 lks, and 4" White Oak, N43E, 61 lks. Our excavation crew found a 1" pipe in the centerline of Schaftsburg Road and a pointed rock, 3.3' south of the pipe at the correct G.L.O. falling distance between M-3 Williamston and A-3 Locke. We also noted that the 24" Maple, S72°30'E, 29.97' used as a witness in your recordation of A-3 Locke, matches closely the 2" Maple, S73E, 47 lks. (31.02') used by John McCreary for M-3 Williamston as well as the 30" White Oak, N43E, 41.10' which closely matches the 4" White Oak N43E, 61 lks. (40.26') used by McCreary for M-3 Williamston in his 1889 survey. Attached are copies of the appropriate G.L.O. field notes for A-3 Locke and McCreary's 1889 survey.
