Per your request, enclosed is the research I have this date performed in the Shiawassee County Surveyors records on the Closing Corner of T 5 N, R 1 E, at the Michigan Meridian.

You will note that we call the position "C-13" as lines "A" & "B" of the standard "bingo code" do not exist in this Section and line "C" is the first available letter lying west of the Standard 1/4 Corner at D-13.

FYI, the Joslin work is usually exceptionally good, Elliot was good in the 30's & 40's, fair in the 50's and poor in the 60's

The card file is a compilation of data from all sources available in the 1970's, by John Quine, County Surveyor. Data that has become available since mid 1970 is not in the card system. Beginning in 1970 the Act 74 & 132 records became the official depository.

I did not get a copy of the Green Hills No. 1 plat as there is a Wiegman survey of several parcels between the plat and the County Line. The plat is likely available 'on-line'.

We would appreciate an opportunity to review the proposed position prior to official acceptance by Ingham County.

Thank you for the preliminary copy of your LCRC of the above captioned position.

Please note that the "Standard Corners" on the Michigan Meridian have been processed and approved by the Clinton County peer group.

It would therefore be required by the Shiawassee County peer group that the true closing corner monument be established on the Meridian at the extension (or crossing) of the Township Line (Ingham/Shiawassee County Line), and further, that the position later marked with a 1" pipe mentioned in A-1, 2, 6 & 7 be recorded as an "Amended Corner" in accord with the Manual of Instructions, 1974, page 140, section 5-41, paragraphs 3 & 4.

I trust the Ingham County peer group will concur with this survey principle.

Upon approval by the Ingham County peer group please duplicate your docie' file and submit it along with a recordable LCRC for Shiawassee County consideration.
