Have a Say in Potter Park Zoo's Future!
Master Plan Design Workshop Announced

LANSING, MI --- Lansing area residents can have a say in the future of Potter Park Zoo at a design workshop to discuss the zoo's new master plan currently in the works.

The workshop will begin at 6 p.m. on Tuesday, October 27 in the Safari Room at Potter Park Zoo, 1301 S. Pennsylvania Ave., Lansing, MI, 48912.

This is the last of a two-part series of meetings held to provide zoo neighbors, members and visitors a unique and fun opportunity to weigh in on design issues for the zoo's master plan. Visitors also will have a chance to meet the staff of Potter Park Zoo, Ingham County Parks Department, and consultants from Jones and Jones, the team heading up the development of the zoo's master plan.

This final workshop will be a chance for participants to see how the design team has applied feedback from previous workshops, held for both the staff and public, to early design concepts. Original conceptual plan designs are available for public review at the Potter Park Zoo office located at 1301 S.
