TO ALL *INGHAM COUNTY* RESIDENTS*

Residents who use syringes, needles and lancets to administer medications at home and produce “sharps” medical waste can prevent injury, infection, and pollution by utilizing the Ingham County Medical Sharps Disposal Program.

Participants can bring in sharps for disposal in any rigid container, including red medical waste containers, coffee cans, or plastic detergent bottles. Sharps will not be accepted in bags or any soft sided container that the sharps can poke through.
