## Order for the Establishment of a Veterans' Treatment Court

## IT IS ORDERED:

The following Local Administrative Orders are hereby rescinded:

Administrative Order 2010-1 (30<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court) Administrative Order 2010-1 (54-A District Court) Administrative Order 2010-2 (54-B District Court) Administrative Order 2010-3 (55th District Court)

The purpose of this order is to establish a Veterans' Treatment Court in Ingham County for the 30<sup>th</sup> Circuit Court and the 54-A, 54-B and 55<sup>th</sup> District Courts upon approval by the State Court Administrative Office (SCAO). All policies and procedures comply with ten key components for a veterans' treatment court, a copy of which is attached as Attachment A. Veterans' Treatment Court will be overseen by the Judges of the 54-B District Court, with the schedule determined at their discretion.

- 1. The court has entered into a Memorandum of Understanding with each participating prosecuting official in the circuit or district court district, a representative of the criminal defense bar, a representative of community treatment providers and other key parties. The Memorandum of Understanding describes the role of each party. A copy of the Memorandum of Understanding is attached as Attachment B.
- 2. The court has established eligibility criteria as part of Attachment B. Any statement or other information obtained as a result of participating in a substance abuse or mental health assessment shall be deemed to be confidential and shall not be used in any criminal prosecution against the veteran.
- 3. No defendant shall be admitted until a complete preadmission screening and substance abuse and/or mental health assessment are completed.
- 4. All defendants shall sign a voluntary written consent to participate in the program.
- 5. The court shall maintain case files in compliance with Trial Court General Schedule 16, the Michigan Case File Management Standards, and Part 2 of Title 42 of the Code of Federal Regulations to assure confidentiality of drug treatment court records.
